

Caterpillar

Take a long over the knee sock and lay it flat so that the heel is on the top as shown below.



Cut out a U shape to within 1 1/2 inches of the heel. This will create the ears.



Turn the sock inside out and sew the ears using either backstitch or zig-zag sitch if using a machine.



Turn the right way out again and stuff the ears and head. Use only a samll amount of stuffing at a time for the ears.



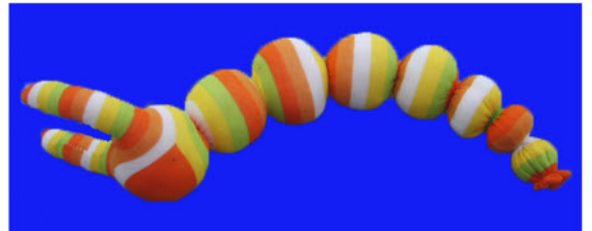
Sew a running stitch just below the stuffing for the head, pull up tight and knot. Do not fasten off.



Next backstitch all the way around below the head stuffing to make extra secure.



Repeat this all the way down the length of caterpillar, with each ball of stuffing getting slightly smaller until you reach the end.



Lastly, sew on the face using embroidery silks.



Your caterpillar is now finished and ready to enjoy!!
